8. Habitat for Humanity – Thanks to the support of the Parish and the Knights of Columbus Council we completed the building of the fourth Habitat home 2013 Ohio Street in November 2011. Ten volunteers worked 82 shifts and volunteered 535 hours over 10 weekends to complete the home. The number of hours marked the highest number of volunteer hours in the four years. The keys to the new home were turned over to Pah Ku & May Doh at a dedication ceremony on November 19.
