

First Reconciliation and First Holy Eucharist

Students receive special, intense preparation for First Reconciliation and First Holy Eucharist. This is done in cooperation with the parent/guardian.

Preparation for First Reconciliation and First Holy Eucharist is a 2-year program, beginning in first grade. The sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist are received for the first time in the second grade. **All candidates for sacraments (Reconciliation and/or First Communion) must provide a copy of their baptism certificate to the Religious Education office by October 1st.** Baptism certificates can be faxed directly to our office at 402-502-7242 by the parish where your child was baptized.

Parent meetings are scheduled during the year so that parents may review the content of the preparation and deepen their own understanding of the sacrament being received. Please see the Religious Formation Calendar for dates and times of these meetings. The Religious Formation department welcomes any questions concerning preparation or celebration of the sacraments.

Children in the third grade or above who have been baptized but have not received Reconciliation or Eucharist can receive preparation through an extra preparation class. Please contact the Religious Formation office at 659-0578 if your child needs this special preparation for the sacraments.
